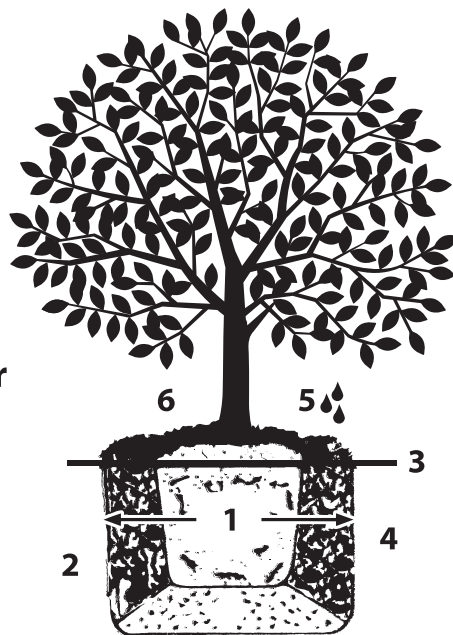


## Angelo's Planting Guide 6 Steps to Success

1. Dig Hole  
twice the width of  
the pot or root ball

2. Prepare Soil  
with **Petitti Planting  
Mix** and **Soil Perfector**

3. Set Plant  
slightly above  
existing soil level



4. Back fill  
the hole adding  
**Osmocote** or  
**Plant-Tone** and  
**Iron-Tone**

5. Water in  
with **Quick Start**  
starter fertilizer

6. Finish  
by applying a  
2 inch layer of  
**Nature Scapes**  
mulch

### Additional Planting Instructions For Trees and Shrubs

After removing the plastic pot from the plant's root system, use a sharp knife or spade to "score" the roots and facilitate their movement into the soil. Remove all strings and/or bindings around the trunk of the plant so it does not become girdled. With balled & burlapped (B&B) plants remove or peel back at least the top 1/3 of burlap before planting. Apply Holly-Tone and Iron-Tone if you are planting an evergreen or acid loving plant; use Plant-Tone and Iron-Tone for deciduous plants that prefer neutral to alkaline soil pH.

Irrigate 1" of water once a week, deeply and thoroughly for deep root establishment.
